Formed by three brothers: violinists Saúl and Arón and cellist Álvaro Bitrán as well as violist Javier Montiel, Cuarteto Latinoamericano has been considered by The London Times as "possessor of an instinct that definitely puts it in the first division of string quartets" and by the Houston Chronicle as "one of the best quartets we've heard since years."
